Seminar Overview

Our youth are exposed to far more today than youth of previous generations. As a result, the temptations that they are faced with are occurring at an earlier age, especially in the area of purity and abstinence. God has provided an answer and an example to fighting these temptations. The answer is found in Psalm 119:9 which states “How can a young person stay pure? By obeying Your Word and following its rules (NLT)”. The example (or at least one of many examples) of how to fight temptations is found in Matthew 4, when Jesus was tempted by the devil. In His responses to the devil, He stated, “It is written.....”. In other words, He was able to stand, because He knew and applied the Word of God.
